Important Vendor/Exhibitor Policies

Be sure to read these policies thoroughly and keep a copy for your records.

- All set-up must be completed between 9:30-11:30 a.m. on Saturday, September 23rd.
 The event begins promptly at 12:00 p.m. Absolutely no booth set-up or moving of booth spaces will be permitted during festival hours.
- Tear-down will be allowed only after the 4:00 p.m. closing; vendors who violate this policy will
 not be accepted to participate in future festivals.
- Food booths must comply with all health department rules and regulations. Food sampling must follow MDA guidelines (<u>www.mda.state.mn.us</u>)
- Deep Roots Festival is moving towards becoming a zero waste event. This means it is
 preferred that all plates, cups utensils, and sampling devices must be compostable or recyclable.
- Tables, chairs, canopies, electricity, and wifi, are not available at this time. Vendors are responsible for providing their own booth/display items. The Sustainable Farming Association is not responsible for damaged exhibit/booth items.
- Please work with neighboring booths to ensure that all displays are visible and accessible to visitors.
- This event is outdoors so please be prepared for wind, rain, etc.
- PROHIBITED ITEMS: The following items are not allowed at the festival: wholesale items, knives, firearms, alcoholic beverages, sexually explicit materials, drug paraphernalia.

Initial	To participate, each vendor must commit to the entire day from 12:00-4:00 p.m. Absolutely no set up or tear down during the festival. Booths must be set up prior to 11:30 am on the day of the event and remain in place until 4:00 pm.
Initial	The festival provides: agreed upon space. The vendor/exhibitor provides attractive booth and signage. Any equipment needed for displays or selling (must fit in booth space), any financial processing equipment and other booth needs.
Initial	Vendors may drive to their booth space to unload their booth items, then must move to the parking area before setting up their booth.
Initial	The following are not allowed: wholesale items, hot food (unless prepared food vendor, then see below), knives, firearms, alcoholic beverages, sexually explicit materials, drug paraphernalia, and unapproved beverages.
Initial	Vendors may bring one additional person to assist at their booth. Any additional persons must pay to attend the event.
